Changes are A-Coming to our Building

UPDATE FROM FACILITIES DIRECTOR, CHRIS GRAHAM

We are well underway to beautify and improve our place of worship. You have noticed the plywood covering the windows...BUT our 1st shipment of glass is being installed on December 5th. We are expecting 20-30 panes per shipment and expect another 2-3 shipments to have the window project completed.

Also we are adding an ADA accessible bathroom in the foyer. Designs are currently being drawn by the engineers. Once the designs are completed, they can be submitted to Mecklenburg County for review and approval. After that we will send them out for bids.

Starting in 2025 we will begin our roof restoration process along with installing new gutters and downspouts. Once all windows are in and the exterior deficiencies are completed, we can then begin laying new flooring.

As with all buildings of this age (nearly 60 years), we're constantly looking to improve the functioning assets of our building, such as the HVAC. We met with an HVAC engineering team this week to discuss possible ways to improve the heating components for the sanctuary, with hopefully a plan and fix in place by early 2025.
