


FACILITIES UPDATE...

We're excited to share that we will begin the construction this month to add a new ADA bathroom, as well as install a new security system.

Additionally we have other projects slated such as adding new HVAC units in the Fellowship Hall and classroom behind it, updating the flooring on the 3rd floor as well as on the lower level for the Children's Ministry.

Future projects include purchasing picnic tables for the front lawn and adding 2 drinking fountains; one on the sanctuary level and one on the ground floor.
